Academic requirements

Undergraduate course

Students will need to have completed one of the following:

- Certificado de Ensino Medio with high grades and the Vestibular PAS
- Recognised UK Foundation course
- One year of university studies at a recognized Brazilian Institution

Students with only the Certificado de Ensino Medio can be considered for the one-year **International Foundation Programme** at Middlesex. Students who successfully complete this course will automatically progress onto a Middlesex degree programme.

Postgraduate course

Successful completion of a Bachelor/Licenciado/Professional Title, of at least 4 years, with a minimum grade of 6.5. MBA requires at least two years of post-graduation work experience at management level.

Some courses may have specific entry requirements such as portfolio or interview. Refer to our website for further details.

English language requirements

We accept a range of English tests, taken within two years of the start of your course, these include:

Undergraduate course

- IELTS 6.0 (with minimum 5.5 in all components)
- Cambridge Advanced Test with minimum grade B.

Postgraduate course

- IELTS 6.5 (with minimum 6.0 in all components)
- Cambridge Advanced Test with minimum grade B.

We also offer **pre-sessional English courses** to students who need to improve their English level to study with us. By the end of the course you will have the academic English and confidence to study on a Middlesex degree.

Scholarships and financial aid

Brazilian Scientific Mobility Programme scholarships

We participate in the Brazilian Scientific Mobility Programme, which offers students scholarships for one year, either as an undergraduate or PhD research student.

The scholarship covers tuition fees, placement or research project, accommodation, living expenses and travel to/from London and pre-sessional English course if required. Interested students need to have already applied for, and been awarded, a scholarship from the Brazilian Scientific Mobility Programme in Brazil.

Middlesex Regional Awards

Regional Award £1,000

If you're a talented student, you may be eligible for a Regional Award of £1,000 towards course fees.

International Merit Award £2,000

We award up to £2,000 to high achieving students. You must apply, we consider your entire application: transcripts, personal statement, references and work experience.

Academic Excellence Award £5,000

If you're a student who has demonstrated academic excellence you can apply for £5,000 towards your course fees.


