Academic requirements

Undergraduate (Bachelor) course

Students will need to have completed one of the following:

- Certificado de Ensino Medio with high grades and the Vestibularor PAS
- Recognised UK Foundation course
- One year of university studies at a recognized Brazilian Institution

Students with only the Certificado de Ensino Medio can be considered for the one-year

International Foundation Certificate.

Students who successfully complete this programme automatically progress onto a degree programme. For more information visit: mdx.ac.uk/foundation

Masters (Postgraduate) course

Successful completion of a good licenciado (generally 3.8 overall grade)/bachelor degree from a recognised institution in a subject relevant to your proposed postgraduate study. MBA requires at least two years of post-graduation work experience at management level.

Some courses have specific entry requirements such as a portfolio or interview. For more information visit:

English requirements

We accept a range of English tests, valid within 2 years of course starting, including:

Bachelor (Undergraduate) course

- IELTS Academic 6.0 (with minimum 5.5 in all components)
- TOEFL (IBT) 72 (at least 17 in listening & writing, 20 in speaking and 18 in reading)

Masters (Postgraduate) course

- IELTS Academic 6.5 (with minimum 6.0 in all components)
- TOEFL (IBT) 87 (at least 21 in listening & writing, 22 in speaking and 23 in reading)

Scholarships and financial aid

Middlesex International Merit Award

You may be eligible for the International Merit Award, awards up to **£5,000** towards either undergraduate or postgraduate fees.

Santander Excellence Scholarship

This **£5,000** award is available to students from Latin America who have demonstrated academic excellence. To qualify you must have applied and been accepted to a postgraduate course at Middlesex.

Chevening scholarships

The Chevening scholarship scheme offers financial support to study for a postgraduate course in the UK.
